THE CRANKHANDLE CLUB was established in 1955 and its objects are to preserve, maintain and encourage the interest in, and ownership of, motor vehicles as defined by the South African Veteran and Vintage Association (SAVVA), and also to foster the preservation of records, literature and memorabilia pertaining to motor vehicles.

The Club possesses a Clubhouse situated at 9 Riebeeck Street, Wynberg and has a very extensive library to aid members in the restoration or rebuilding of their cars. This library is one of the finest in the Southern Hemisphere. The Clubhouse is open to members every Wednesday evening from 20h00. More formal meetings, as well as social functions, are held from time to time at the Clubhouse. On the last Sunday of every month a "Natter" is held from 10h00 to 12h30 at Timour Hall, Timour Hall Road, Plumstead unless otherwise advertised. Members bring their cars, sometimes in various stages of restoration, and natter with other members over a cup of tea.

Because the Club is associated to the South African Veteran and Vintage Association (SAVVA), members may participate in rallies and competitions, which are held under the auspices of SAVVA from time to time.

An Application for Membership form is attached. It is the responsibility of the applicant to have himself proposed and seconded by Club members of not less than one year's standing. If the applicant is not personally known to any Club member, it is recommended that he or she attends one of the end-of-month "Natters" or visits the Clubhouse on a Wednesday evening from 20h00 onwards, and makes the acquaintance of the Chairman or a Committee Member. ## ENTRANCE FEE R300.00

This fee is waived if the applicant is already a fully paid up member of a SAVVA affiliated club provided that such club is outside an 80 Kms radius from the centre of Cape Town and that documentary proof of such membership is supplied. This fee includes one name badge.

## ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTIONS

There are two main categories of membership – FULL membership for individuals residing within 80 kms of the GPO, Cape Town and COUNTRY membership for individuals residing more than 80 kms from the GPO, Cape Town. FAMILY and JUNIOR (from 12 to 18 years) membership are also available and such members enjoy all the benefits of Full or Country membership, except that they do not have voting rights.

If the applicant or his or her spouse join together as FULL members, the entrance fee for the spouse will be waived and the subscription fee is indicated below under JOINT. If the spouse of a member or an applicant joins as a FAMILY member, the entrance fee for him or her will be waived. For the current club year, no additional subscription fee is payable.
